The FM & UL-ULC Firestop Exams are based on FCIA's Firestop Manual of Practice (MOP), the FM & UL program guides, and systems selection and analysis. These exams are used for Contractor personnel to become FM 4991 Approved Contractor and UL-ULC Qualified Contractor Program DRIs. For Special Inspectors, passing the exam proves firestopping competency to the Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ), required by the IBC's Chapter 17. Passing an exam is also a requirement in IAS AC 291 for the Inspector to become a Responsible Person. The Test Prep Sessions help prepare individuals for the FM & UL-ULC Firestop Exams and help support individual preparation for these rigorous exams, further strengthening your firestopping knowledge.
