In order for Firestopping and Effective Compartmentation to work, all wall, floor and ceiling penetrations need to become fire-resistance-rated and smoke-resistance-rated, just like the walls. Specific Design standards, rigorous FM 4991 and ULC Qualified Contractor Program Installation protocols, systematic and thorough Inspections and comprehensive ongoing Maintenance and Management programs (DIIM) are required to keep a tested and listed Firestop SYSTEM working for the life-cycle of the building. One detail missed, one step skipped and the system is voided and the occupancy has the potential for breach.
