

FCIA RETURNS TO THE MIDDLE EAST

Yep. You read that right. FCIA is coming back to the Middle East this June with our firestop education and the FM & UL Firestop Exams! FINALLY!

The International Code Council's "Cycle B" Code Development Hearings cover the IBC Chapter 1, Administrative and Chapter 15 and 16, Structural Sections. Key proposals altering Section 104 will be heard, specifically the alternative methods section. In Structural, more debate takes place on Performance Based Structural Fire Design. The hearings start March 27 in Rochester, NY and run through April 7.


